

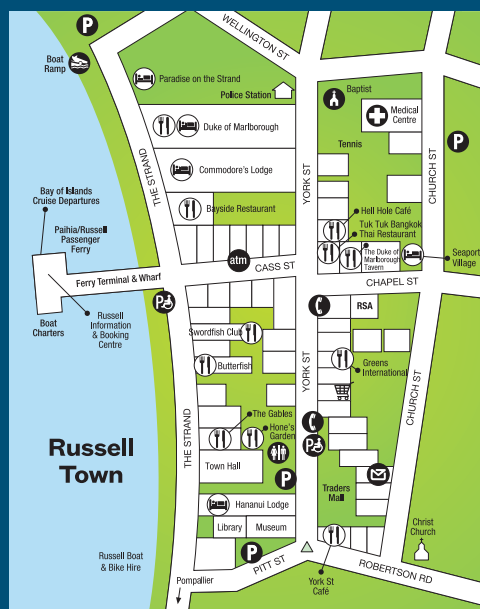

## Guest Information

All tours, cruises and fishing trips operating around the Bay of Islands depart from the Russell Wharf, just 5-7 minutes walk from the park. You can also walk to Long Beach in just 10 minutes, where you can safely swim or relax on the sandy shore.

Our park is suitable for all types of holiday makers including families, couples, groups and solo travelers. The area is renowned for its unspoilt beauty and historical significance.

### Park policies

We seek your cooperation with the following policies. They are to ensure your stay and the stay of all other guests is as enjoyable as possible.

### Alcohol:

The consumption of alcohol within the park is restricted to your unit, site or camp kitchen (within daylight hours only). Anyone not acting responsibly may be asked to leave. All bottles/cans need to be disposed of accordingly. Please do not walk around the premises with open alcoholic beverages.

### Check-in:

After 2.00pm for all villas, glamping tents and cabins. After 11am for powered and unpowered sites.

### Check-out:

Before 10.00am on the day of your departure. An extended stay can often be arranged - just come and see us at reception before 10.00am to check availability.

### Conduct:

To ensure all our guests have a great holiday, please use consideration at all times throughout your stay. Excessive noise or aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated.

### Defibrillator:

This is located behind site #138, and is for use in an emergency.

### Dog-friendly:

We have a limited amount of dog-friendly sites available all year round excluding Christmas/ New Year and long weekends. We also have dog-friendly Villas. Speak to staff regarding our pet policy.

### Emergency bell:

This is located outside the front door of reception and is to be used for late arrivals and emergencies only.

### Food:

Food stored in communal kitchen is at your own risk. Please ensure all items are clearly marked with your name and departure date. The fridges will be cleared weekly and anything unmarked will be discarded.

### Messages:

Messages will be taken at reception and delivered to guests whenever possible.

### Noise:

Please be considerate of noise levels whilst staying within our park. Quiet time is from 10.30pm to 7.00am - please respect your fellow holidaymakers and remember we are a family holiday destination. The way the park is situated means that noise travels quite easily, so please keep this in mind during early mornings and late evenings, when other guests may be sleeping.

### Playground:

Children under 12 must be supervised at all times to ensure their safety. Jumping Pillow is on at 0900 until 7.30pm. No shoes or any hard objects to be on or thrown on pillow. Playground hours are 7.30am to 9.00pm.

### Powered & Unpowered Sites:

Caravans and Campervans must have a current electrical warrant of fitness and comply with LPG standards. If tenting, you must have connected a Residual Current Device (RCD). These are available for hire at reception if needed.

### Reception:

Please refer to our website for office hours. For after hours urgent enquiries or noise disturbances please press the night bell at reception or call 027 710 4000

### Safety:

Please drive at walking pace throughout our park (under 5km/hr). All roads within the park are shared zones, so please be aware of pedestrians.

### Scooters, skateboards & bicycles:

The use of this equipment is allowed during daylight hours only and is limited to the flat areas of the park. Please keep your children from using skateboards & scooters on elevated areas as this can be quite dangerous. Please do not ride near the communal facilities and always be wary of cars/boats. Helmets must be worn at all times and children under 12 must be supervised.

### General information

**Boat washing & engine flushing:** All boat washing and engine flushing is to be conducted in the allocated boat wash area outside the park. Fish filleting is permitted at the fish filleting station. No boats to be parked at the fish filleting station except whilst washing boat or flushing engine. Refer to park map or ask reception for locations.

**Gas BBQ:** Located next to the camp kitchen. Personal BBQs are not permitted on unit/ cabin decks. No charcoal or open fires are permitted in the park.

**Kitchen/dining/tv room:** Automatic lights turn off at 10.30pm.

**Laundry:** The first laundry is located at the men's end of the shower/toilet block. The second laundry is located next to reception which is open during reception hours only. All washers & dryers operate with \$2 coins

- \$4 per load. All machines require you have your own laundry detergent. This can be purchased from reception.

**Rubbish: Please Recycle** - Recycle bins can be found at the northern end of the shower/ toilet block and down near boat bay "P" on the field. Also on corner of Hillsidegrove.

**Showers:** Our water comes from a natural spring and is therefore metered. A push button timer will operate the shower for 5 minutes.

**Telephone:** A public card phone is located on Long Beach Road next to the park boundary.

**Water:** Our water is of excellent quality and is drinkable from all taps within the park unless clearly marked "not suitable for drinking". Please be mindful of water usage as we do not have town water supply in Russell. All water is supplied via a natural spring, which is a limited resource and needs to be conserved.

**WiFi:** Unlimited Wi-fi is available throughout the park. Please be aware because we are in a hollow it can be intermittent (however the main repeaters are in the Kitchen). Ask our reception staff for the current password.
